REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- MUST BE A CANADIAN CITIZEN OR LANDED IMMIGRANT
- MUST BE PHYSICALLY FIT AND ABLE TO PASS THE FIRE PROGRAM FITNESS TEST
- CLASS 5 DRIVER'S LICENSE (OR EQUIVALENT)
- CURRENT FIRST AID/CPR CERTIFICATION

BENEFICIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- EXPERIENCE AND/OR TRAINING IN WILDFIRE SUPPRESSION
- HARDWORKING AND SELF-MOTIVATED
- TEAM PLAYERS
- WILLING TO TRAVEL AND SPEND EXTENDED PERIODS OF TIME IN REMOTE FIRE CAMPS
- PREVIOUS OUTDOOR/WILDERNESS AND MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE
- PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE OPERATING SMALL ENGINE EQUIPMENT
- KNOWLEDGE OF FIRE BEHAVIOUR AND WEATHER

TO APPLY:

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE ABOVE REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION, YOU **MUST** FORWARD THE FOLLOWING:
 - A COMPLETED CIVIL SERVICE APPLICATION (AVAILABLE AT CANADA EMPLOYMENT CENTRES AND MANITOBA CONSERVATION DISTRICT OFFICES), OR RESUME;
 - A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR DRIVER'S LICENCE AND FIRST AID AND CPR CERTIFICATES;
 - THREE (3) REFERENCES (A MINIMUM OF ONE WORK REFERENCE)
