Descriptions:

Academic and Facilities Fees:

<u>Tuition fees</u> cover the cost of instruction and examinations. Part-time students pay pro-rated fees per course.

<u>Book Fee</u> covers the cost of textbooks, field guides, and printed materials during the given semester.

<u>Student Services Fee</u> includes administrative services, print credits, write-in-the- rain field books, personal first aid kits, and key fobs.

<u>IT Fee</u> Each term students are charged an IT fee, which is being introduced to offset the cost of updating and purchasing technological resources used by the college community. These resources include computer labs, field computers, digital projectors, wireless internet, software, IT supports, etc.

<u>Transportation Fee</u> covers the costs associated with student transportation during the academic year. This would include bus rentals and or fuel for MCFT-owned transportation.

<u>Student Facilities Fee</u> For each term in which they are enrolled, students are charged a facilities fee that provides funds to renew college facilities such as classrooms, laboratories, buildings, and infrastructure at MCFT. These funds may be put toward projects like improving electrical and ventilation systems; repairing or replacing building components such as roofs, windows, and classrooms; renovating or purchasing items such as seating and laboratory updates, and servicing infrastructure needs such as water pipes and roadways.

<u>Student Council Fee</u> Full-time and part-time undergraduate students are charged a mandatory Student Council fee at the beginning of the fall and winter terms. This fee funds a variety of student-related services and events and the operation of the Student Council, which is responsible for representing the student body.

<u>Counseling Services Fee</u> helps offset the costs associated with in-person counseling services provided on campus during the academic year.

<u>Field Equipment Fee</u> covers the cost of an incoming student's field equipment kit. Each student is provided with essential forestry tools selected by the faculty. This equipment is used throughout the program and the students get to keep the gear provided in the kit. Kits can include items such as prisms, calipers, field vests, diameter tapes etc

<u>Lab Fees (Fish and Wildlife Prg only)</u> that cover the cost of consumable laboratory materials and supplies used by a student during the academic year. This can include gloves, batteries, cleaning supplies, skeleton mounting supplies, dissection kits, coveralls, etc

<u>Graduation Fee</u> covers the cost of the diploma and covers the ceremony expenses, mailing fees, and other expenses associated with graduation

Residence:

Residence Fee includes the rental of either a single or double room in one of MCFT's residence buildings. This fee covers cleaning fees and supplies, HVAC services, heating, power, water bills, etc.

Laundry Fee covers the maintenance of laundry facilities in the residence.

<u>Telecommunications Fee</u> includes residence internet services, maintenance of security services, electronic door fob access, and maintenance.
